Exec Elections

Financial Review

- Patrick provided high level overview of the financials for the newcomers
- Profit ahead of previous year driven by programs registrations

Membership Update

Volunteers Update

- Rock N Roll Half (March 21) - already secured water station on Rock Creek Park, and 6 or 7 already registered; club will also get application for Ironman Foundation grant

- CB 10 Miler (April 12) - Hains Point spot confirmed; need to “confirm roster” sometime in February
- Justine/Jette to confirm that these events are on the club calendar
- Group discussed Kinetic race volunteering (taking over a water stop or similar)
- Discussed brainstorming new incentives

Programs Update

- All programs open - Advanced Programs closing soon
- NTP just started signups (January 1) and they are trickling in slowly
- Next month report on OSP membership gain/loss (this year's enrollment at 53)
- Ironman Program enrollment is up to 11 this year
- Clinics - in process of reserving facilities

Training Update
